

## **PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVES ON COUNCIL/PRACTICE STANDARDS COMMITTEE- SEEKING NOMINATIONS**

The mandate of the NBCDH is to advance and maintain the standard of dental hygiene in the province of NB and of governing and regulating the profession of dental hygiene in the interest on the public of NB.

With that mandate in mind, the NBCDH is actively seeking expression of interest from members of the public for candidates to be appointed on the NBCDH council and practice standards committee. Interested candidates must submit their nominations with a short resume to be then submitted to the Minister of Health for the final appointment to these committees for a two-year term (2023- 2025) with the possibility of reappointments.

Public representatives must not be a past member of the NBCDH, nor be directly linked to an oral health professional and the oral health profession.

### **Characteristics of potential candidates:**

In keeping with the College's commitment to excellence, Council is seeking individuals who have characteristics that support the mandate and values of the organization:

- Ability to see the big picture and is willing to deal with the long-term vision of the organization.
- Willingness to delegate the operational details to others.
- Willingness to honour policies and decisions established by the NBCDH Council.
- Ability and willingness to participate assertively in deliberation while respecting the opinions of others.
- Willingness to engage in the orientation, training and ongoing study and application of our governance model.
- Experience on Boards is beneficial but not required.
- Basic computer knowledge and accessibility is a must.

### **Council Role and responsibility:**

- Attend all council meetings and AGM. Council meetings are held a minimum of 3 times per year (one day to two days) with the possibility of videoconferences held 2 to 3 times a year. Meeting dates are scheduled by the Council at a time agreeable to all council members. All reasonable expenses are covered by the College.

- Attend all educational sessions on regulatory matters required to fulfill the duties of council member.
- Providing governance and leadership to the College through its administration of the Act, Rules and Policies.
- Providing direction to the Executive Director/Registrar.
